Join us each day this month in prayer and praise for the work of Christ in the lands of Russia.

Reflection: We begin April with thanksgiving and prayer for you—our faithful partners in ministry... For this reason also... we have not ceased to pray for your and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all spiritual wisdom and understanding (Colossians 1:9).

Praise the Lord for His provision of funds for SGA-sponsored seminaries and Bible institutes in the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS). We are thankful for the opportunity to help prepare hundreds of faithful workers for labor in God's vast harvest fields.

Please pray for SGA-sponsored summer camp workers and the attending children in advance of camp season. Especially intercede for our Russian brothers and sisters, who carry on ministry with the antimissionary law passed last year hanging over them.

Pray for the directors and staff of SGA's international offices in Canada, New Zealand, Australia, and the United Kingdom. We are thankful to God for the global outreach to Russianspeakers that He has made possible.

Please pray that God will continue to grant wisdom to SGA president

Bob Provost as he oversees SGA's ministries here and in the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS).

Russia

Pray for the students at the SGA-sponsored Novosibirsk Biblical-Theological Seminary. Pray also for Pastor Eduard Genrikh, the president of the seminary, asking for God's ongoing blessing and wisdom.

Intercede for SGA's new *Reach Russia Now* initiative, which is
beginning with emphasis on reaching
the vast Far East with the Gospel.
Pray for the funds needed to train
missionary pilots and provide them
with ministry resources.

In Russian culture, church congregations that do not have their own building are viewed with suspicion, and many small churches are not able to afford construction of a church. Please lift this urgent need before the Lord today.

Praise God for the staff at SGA's Moscow RMC, led by Valery Kazakov. We are thankful to the Lord for the wonderful team He has brought together for the service of the churches He is building across vast Russia.

Pray for Pastor Alexei Smirnov, president of the Russian UECB. He and his fellow pastors will need great wisdom and discernment from the Lord as restrictions on evangelical churches continue to tighten.

Ukraine

Continue to intercede for SGA-sponsored missionary pastors as they distribute food and other aid to war-shattered families in eastern Ukraine through our Crisis Evangelism Fund. Ask for safety as they travel in what is still a very dangerous situation.

12 Join us in praising God for the servant leadership of Pastor Valery Antonyuk, president of the Ukrainian Union of Evangelical Christians-Baptists (UECB). May the Lord encourage Valery's heart as he serves congregations across Ukraine.

13 Irpen Biblical Seminary and Odessa Theological Seminary are the two primary UECB Bible schools sponsored by SGA in Ukraine. Pray today for the faculty and students as they study the Word of God and prepare future servants of Christ for fruitful ministry.

Lift up the staff of SGA's Kiev RMC in prayer, led by director Ruslan Muratayev. With summer camp season nearing, our team will be very busy helping get children's Bibles and other ministry resources to the churches.

Pray for SGA-sponsored missionary pastor Yury K, who serves in war-torn eastern Ukraine.

Ask the Lord to encourage his heart as he faithfully plants churches and preaches the Gospel to many who are waiting and wanting to hear.

Belarus

16 Easter Sunday: Remember
Jesus Christ, risen from the
dead, descendant of David, according
to my Gospel... (2 Timothy 2:8). Join
together with us and our brothers and
sisters across the CIS in proclaiming
the risen Savior! May many be drawn
to saving faith in Christ as they hear
the life-changing Gospel.

Missionary pastors and their families across Belarus face many governmental restrictions that hinder their ministries. Yet God is greater, the Gospel is proclaimed, and the lost are being drawn to Christ. We praise Him with thanksgiving for His enabling power.

Pray today for Dr. Viktor Krutko, president of the Belarussian UECB. We are thankful to God for Viktor's strong leadership and commitment to the inerrant Word of God.

1 9 Intercede for the staff of SGA's Minsk RMC, led by Piotr Podrez. In addition to their busy RMC duties, they are also individually involved in the fruitful ministries of their churches.

Belarussian foreign minister Vladimir Makei recently addressed a meeting of foreign diplomats and urged the restoration of "the level of trust between countries." Pray for improved relations with the West and a loosening of tight restrictions on evangelical churches.

Central Asia, Caucasus, and Israel

Lift SGA-sponsored missionary pastor Dr. Levan in prayer today as he carries on with his fruitful ministry in the Caucasus nation of Georgia. We are thankful for this dedicated servant of Christ and his tireless labors for the sake of the Gospel.

2 Pray for the SGA-sponsored Almaty Bible Institute in Kazakhstan, where 98 students are currently enrolled. Join us in praising the Lord for His gracious provision for this vitally important Bible school in the heart of Central Asia.

Please continue to remember the Russian-speaking students at our Bible college in Israel. Ask God to increase our resources to help these students and their growing congregations in the land of the Bible.
