**1 Reflection:** We begin November with James' wonderful reminder of our God's faithful provision for His people . . . *Every good thing given and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shifting shadow* (James 1:17).

**2** Pray today for SGA president Michael Johnson as you go before the Lord. May God continue to grant him and our leadership team abundant wisdom in these challenging days of ministry across the former Soviet Union.

**3** Intercede for the staff and families of SGA's international offices in Canada, the United Kingdom, Australia, and New Zealand. We praise and thank the Lord for their faithfulness in service to Christ and for the sake of the Gospel.

**4** Continue to lift up SGA-sponsored missionary pastors and their churches as they continue to reach out to needy families impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Even in the midst of this great tragedy, the Lord is using it to bring many to Himself in saving faith.

## RUSSIA



**5** The SGA-sponsored *Orphans Reborn* ministry reaches thousands of Russian-speaking children with the love of Christ and the life-changing Gospel. Intercede in prayer that God will increase provision for this vital outreach.

**6** Pray for Dr. Piotr Mitskevich, president of the Russian Union of Evangelical Christians-Baptists (UECB). Ask God to grant him wisdom and direction in his national leadership role.

**7** Intercede for Valery Kazakov, director of SGA's Moscow Regional Ministry Center (RMC). In a country as vast in size as Russia, coordinating the equipping of churches and missionary pastors can be a challenging task, yet our RMC team does it with great joy and commitment.

**8** Pray for Pastor Eduard Genrikh, president of the SGA-sponsored Novosibirsk Biblical-Theological Seminary. With the Russian government stepping up scrutiny of evangelical Bible schools and ministries, Eduard and his fellow seminary leaders will need great

wisdom from the Lord in the days ahead.

**9** Vladimir Nenastin is a faithful missionary pastor sponsored by SGA in Russia's Nizhny Novgorod region. We praise and thank the Lord for Vladimir's joyful, fruitful ministry, and lift him up in prayer today.

## BELARUS
