1 Reflection: In this new year, we are thankful to show our love for Christ by loving one another . . . *As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another as good stewards of the manifold grace of God* (1 Peter 4:10).

2 Given the severity of winter in the former Soviet Union, SGA-supported Compassion Ministry is all the more important as the churches face many requests for help from needy families. Pray for increased resources to provide food parcels and other aid where it is needed the most.

3 Pray for Bill Ball, director of SGA/Canada, and Sue Petten, his assistant. We praise and thank the Lord for our Canadian team, their supporting partners and churches who help make much ministry possible.

4 Pray for SGA's leadership team comprised of our president, Michael Johnson, chief financial officer Beverly Braunsky, and vice presidents Eric Mock and Garland Gould. Ask for God's continued guidance and wisdom as they oversee SGA's ministries in the CIS and in the US.
