29 It is never too early to begin praying in advance for upcoming Christmas ministries across Russia and her neighboring countries. We pray that thousands more children will be reached with the Gospel through *Immanuel's Child* this coming season.

30Pray for the SGA-sponsored *Orphans Reborn* ministry across the former Soviet Union. Thousands of lonely, forgotten children have been reached with the Gospel and the love of Christ through the years. Pray for even more open doors in the days ahead.

31 Reflection: Let us conclude the month with Asaph's song . . . I shall remember the deeds of the Lord; Surely I will remember Your wonders of old. I will meditate on all Your work and muse on Your deeds (Psalm 77:11-12).



24 Pray for Alexander Karyakov, director of the SGA-supported Almaty Bible Institute in Kazakhstan. Ask the Lord to grant Alexander wisdom in his leadership role, and adequate resources to keep the school operating at full capacity.

25 Pastor Sergei Kondaurov is the president of the UECB in Kazakhstan, following Pastor Franz Tissen who held the office for many years. We praise and thank the Lord for the pastors and leaders of the faithful Kazakh churches, and for the advance of the Gospel there.

26 Please continually pray for SGA president Michael Johnson and our mission's leadership
